

Report of circle conference of AIBSNLEA MH circle held on 29th April 2023 at Mumbai

Vivek Wankhede, in his key note addressed welcomed all the dignities and thank them for their auspicious presence to make the circle conference highly successful. He elaborated in details the formation of AIBSNLEA, developmental issues, HR issues, circle issues in his keynote address.

Shri. Prashant Patil, CGM CNTX, highlighted the role of transmission network in telecom and efforts being taken to update and upgrade the network. Rohit Sharma, CGM, MH circle, informed the house, that MH circle has earned 512 cr of revenue in last financial year which is highest, connected 21K branches of SBI, 4083 Branches of Bank of India, the space renting out is in full swing and had a target of 70% space in every building to be rented out this year. Scrapping was the priority and target revenue to be increased by 20% this year he said. On HR issues he said the circle admin will be more accommodative to the issues of the employees by making the transfer policy more transparent by giving choices. He thanked AIBSNLEA MH for inviting him for the conference and giving opportunity to interact.

The highlight of the meeting was well studied speech of GS AIBSNLEA Com V Shaji who put light on various issues, objected the use of perform or Perish line repeatedly used by management, he told that BSNL must implement pay revision, extend revise pay scales as there is very little extra amount required and already BSNL employees with their hard work had earned more than that during last 2 years specially after implementing mega VRS in Jan 2020.

The meeting concluded with Vote of thanks by Mrs. Rashmi Sharma. The open session was beautifully anchored by Smt Bhosale, retired AO MH circle office Mumbai. The meeting was followed by the lunch at 2.30pm.

Afternoon session started at 3.30pm, Com V Shaji, GS AIBSNLEA CHQ replied to the various queries of the members and the session was conclude with the speech by Com. Vivek Wankhede, CS, AIBSNLEA MH. The body was dissolved and Com C M Saste was unanimously nominated as the chairman for the election process.
