A meeting of the AUAB was held at 16:00 hrs. on 20.11.2018, at NFTE's office, New Delhi. Com. Chandeshwar Singh, Chairman, AUAB, presided over the meeting. Com.P.Abhimanyu, Convenor, welcomed every one and presented the agenda items.

The meeting discussed about the ways and means of organising the indefinite strike effectively from 03.12.2018. The following decisions are taken unanimously:-

- (1) An All India tour programme is to be organised, eventhough the time available for organising the tour programme is very limited. Still, General Secretaries and other CHQ office bearers of the constituents of the AUAB should participate in this tour programme and address the meetings.
- (2) A massive campaign should be unleashed among the general public, to mobilise their support for the success of the struggle and settlement of the demands. Street corner meetings may be organised in each and every town and city. These street corner meetings should be organised from 01.12.2018, till the end of the strike. Especially, all the Non-Executives and Executives should participate in these street corner meetings on the days of the strike. Flex banners, placards, etc., should be displayed in these meetings. The general public should be educated why the survival of BSNL is necessary for the people. The pro-private and anti-BSNL actions of the government should be highlighted in these street corner meetings.
- (3) In these street corner meetings, hand bills should be distributed in thousands, to the public, explaining the issues.
- (4) A press statement should be issued by the AUAB, explaining the demands. Letters to be written to all the Central Trade Unions, seeking their support.
- (5) Meetings should be organised at circle and district levels on 30.11.2018. Central Trade Unions, unions and associations of Central Government, State Government, Bank, Insurance, etc., should be invited for these meetings and the issues should be explained, so as to get their support.
- (6) The AUAB will design posters in English and Hindi and it will be uploaded on the websites of all unions and associations. Similar posters should be printed at circle and district levels, including in local languages, for organising the strike.
- (7) An explanatory note, on the demands contained in the strike notice, should be given to the Secretary, Telecom and CMD BSNL.
- (8) State Assembly elections are taking place in Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Telangana, Chhattisgarh and Mizoram. The meeting decided that exemption from strike shall be given to the officials who are engaged for election duty (only for the days of election duty).
