Request for immediate release of outstanding dues to BSNL- reg. Subject:

Respected Sir,

It is constrained to bring to your kind notice that the Salary for the month of August 2019 has not been disbursed to BSNL Employees till date. Sir, this is the 3rd time in this year, that the BSNL Management has not disbursed the Salary in time to its employees. It has caused serious demoralization, resentment and frustration amongst the BSNL employees. It would be very difficult for BSNL to meet even its fund requirement for monthly Salary due to heavy dip in cash flow during past one year. The Salary for the month of February 2019 was paid on 15th March 2019 and the Salary for the month of July 2019 was also paid on 5th August 2019 only. Further, the gap between monthly revenue and bare expenses to continue operations in BSNL is a going concern has reached a level where continuing with BSNL operations could be nearly impossible without immediate financial support to BSNL.

BSNL is facing severe financial crisis and not able to pay even Electricity Bills, Towers Rent, Vehicle Running Expenses, Fuel Expenses, Contractual Labour Bills, Payment to Vendors, Telecom Infra Service Providers and Local Cable TV Operators bills etc. Further, Bank EMI Payments, GPF Contribution as well as Recoveries, EPF and Reimbursement of Medical Claims in respect of the working Employees & BSNL retirees are delayed. The OPEX, CAPEX, Statutory and other Liabilities are also pending for more than Rs.14,000 Crores and it is likely to increase in the months to come.

In this regard, we would like to bring to your kind notice that huge amount recoverable from DoT is pending since long as detailed below.

Claims Recoverable from DoT:

Rs. 3300 Crores.

2. Interest of BWA Spectrum

Rs. 2200 Crores.

3. Refund of excess paid Pension Contribution:

Rs. 2800 Crores

Further, It is also not out of place to mention that the Compensation for the Maintenance of about 17000 Telephone Exchanges in non-profitable Rural areas is also pending to the tune of Rs.19,000 Crores.

In view of the foregoing, we would therefore, request your good self to kindly intervene in the matter and cause to issue necessary instructions to the officers concerned in DoT for the immediate release of above said outstanding dues from DoT to BSNL so as to disburse the August 2019 Salary and payment of other pending bills by BSNL.
