Subject : Appointment of SAG officers of Indian P&T Accounts & Finance service Gr. A in BSNL/MTNL on deemed deputation basis – our protest against.

Ref. : DOT letter No. 2-01/2006-SEA-I dated 24.09.2009 (copy enclosed)

Hon'ble Sir,

We would like to draw your kind attention in the above mentioned subject matter wherein DOT has issued OM dated 24.09.2009 regarding appointment of SAG officers of Indian P&T Accounts & Finance service Gr. A in BSNL/MTNL on deemed deputation basis. It is against the terms and conditions of absorption process, since the absorption of Gr. A officers of Telecom Finance & Accounts in BSNL has been completed further appointment of SAG level officers on deemed deputation basis is in violation of the Govt. decision.

It is understood that BSNL Management wrote a letter to the Administrative Ministry in year 2006 for the appointment of SAG level officers of Indian P&T Accounts & Finance Service Gr. A in BSNL on deemed deputation basis for a period of 2-3 years. The case was taken up by the DOT to DPE to allow deemed deputation of DOT officers to BSNL but the same was denied by DPE. Hence deemed deputation of un-absorbed Gr. A officers could not be allowed.

BSNL has already notified BSNLMS RRs (Gr. A RRs) to fill up the vacant Gr. A equivalent posts i.e. STS/JAG/SAG/HAG from its Executives or through some recruitment process. The deemed deputation against vacant Gr. A equivalent posts in BSNL is not at all justified and it is against the terms and conditions of absorption.

It is worthwhile to mention that DOT administration is continuously making efforts to complete the absorption process of ITS officers in BSNL at the earliest. So it will be against the Govt. of India's policy.

In view of the above background, and as per the decision taken in the Joint Forum meeting held on 07.10.2009, we would request you to kindly intervene in the matter so that appointment of SAG level officers of Indian P&T Accounts & Finance service Gr. A in BSNL is immediately stopped.
