



The above procedure had already been followed by BSNL in the exam held in December 2000 vide letter No.10-1/2001-/DE dated 8.2.2006 declaring 87 candidates as qualified with grace marks.

It is also pertinent to mention here that this was the last examination conducted with old syllabus and no further examination is expected to be held with the old syllabus.

Considering points like, shortage, granting the grace marks with candidates of reserved category, huge number of vacant posts, no further exam in old syllabus, etc. **it is requested that the grace marks up to 6 in any subject, may kindly be granted to all the candidates. And/or allow a relaxation to the candidates by way of dispensing marks obtained in all papers** as was done in the case of Departmental JTO examination held in September 2000 vide order No.12-15/2002-de DT. 10.3.2003 of Joint Dy. Director (General), BSNL Corporate Office in which the required aggregate marks was relaxed by the competent authority by dispensed with marks of all papers obtained by them.
