Sub : Resolution on immediate repatriation of unabsorbed ITS officers:


The United Forum of BSNL Executives' Associations met at New Delhi on 09.03.2010 and unanimously adopted resolution on immediate repatriation of Group A officers who have not opted for **absorption in BSNL and continue to be on so called deemed deputation**. We believe that the Govt. recognizes the importance of this issue and the need to resolve it as quickly as possible.

We completely disagree with the perception that non resolution of this issue has no impact and is not relevant to the growth of BSNL. The issue not only has a direct and foremost bearing on the viability of BSNL but its non resolution by the Govt. due to lack of political and bureaucratic will to resolve it has led to serious issues adversely and irretrievably affecting the growth of BSNL.

We thus urge upon the Govt. to initiate immediate steps in the direction of expeditious settlement of this vital issue. Our considered opinion on this issue is that any further delay by the Govt. in addressing this key issue will be the last nail in the coffin of BSNL.


